Project Overview:

This project involved the full reconstruction of Barclay Street from West Broadway to Broadway in Lower Manhattan. (NYCDDC, \$1M, 2004)

Barclay Street Reconstruction New York, NY

The existing roadway will be removed and replaced with a new concrete and asphalt composite roadway. Specific items of work include:

- New 9" concrete road base with 3" asphalt concrete overlay
- Installation of 1175 lf of granite curb
- Catch basin and chute installations
- New concrete sidewalks
- Sidewalk vault repair
- Pavement markings, signage and landscaping
- Extensive coordination with the utilities and new 35 story residential building constructed on project street



Due to the sensitive nature of this project, LiRo works very closely with the local community board, city agencies, and politicians. A community construction liaison is assigned to the project. Numerous meetings were held to inform and aid residents and merchants to minimize any disruption caused by the project.
